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Dear Editor, we would like to share ideas on the publication "Addressing the vaccination hesitancy: communication, behavior and literature"¹. Galletti noted that «the specific information to be delivered in the fight against vaccination hesitancy is embedded within the general process of scientific communication, which brings complex issues into common terms»¹.
